

Dr. Susan Whealler Johnston - Biography

Dr. Susan Whealler Johnston has over 30 years of service in higher education as a faculty member, campus administrator, and national higher education association leader. In 2018, she was named president and CEO of the National Association of College and University Business Officers (NACUBO). Prior to joining NACUBO, she served as executive vice president and chief operating officer of the Association of Governing Boards of Universities and Colleges (AGB). Prior to joining AGB, she was professor of English and Dean of Academic Development at Rockford University. She also served as dean of Regent's College, Rockford's campus in London.

Susan serves on the boards of Rollins College and Radford University, and she is immediate past chair of the board of the Southern Education Foundation. She is also a member of the academic affairs committee of the board of Rockford University. She is a member of the advisory committees of the National Institute on Learning Outcomes Assessment and the National Survey of Student Engagement.

Susan earned her Ph.D. and M.A. from Purdue University in English and her B.A. *summa cum laude* in English from Rollins College. She has an honorary doctorate from Rockford University.
