Richard M. Dempsey, P.E., has served as the Associate Vice President for Facilities Management at the University of Texas at Dallas since the summer of 2006. He previously served as the Assistant Vice President for Facilities Management at the University of Texas of the Permian Basin in Odessa, Texas for eight and half years.
